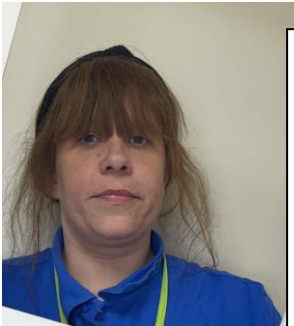

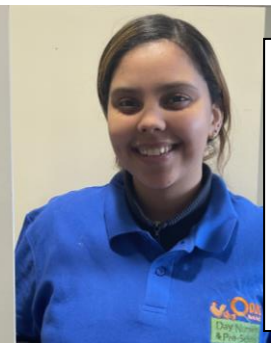
*I am pleased to introduce Owen, Emma and Naz.*

#### Baby
