Covid 19 Updates-

Dear parent/guardian,

In order to continue to keep both child and staff as safe as possible against Covid.

Please can I ask that if your child or anyone within your household develops any of the following Covid-19 symptoms that you do not bring your child to the setting and notify the Manager.

Your child would need a PCR test NOT a lateral flow test.

- Temperature of 37.8 or above
- A new or continuous cough
- Loss or change to your taste or sense of smell.

If anyone within your household is identified as having had close recent contact with someone who has tested positive, please follow the government guidelines, and isolate accordingly.

Please notify the setting Manager immediately. If you child develops any of the above symptoms whilst in the setting, you will be contacted to collect you child.

Your child and household would need to isolate until results of PCR test are received. Please forward these test results to manager. If a child does need to isolate the room will be cleaned and a fogging machine will be utilised in the room.

This will provide a further level of infection control against Coronavirus, on top of the extensive procedures that is already have in place in the setting.

Can I kindly ask that only one parent attends the setting when dropping off or collecting your child and that all parents wear a face covering and continue to remain at a 2-metre distance using the markings in place.

I would like to reassure you that we are taking every precaution to remain COVID-19 secure within the setting to ensure the safety of all our parents, staff, and children.
